Anthony Galloway is one of South Africa's most experienced specialists in business consulting, training and development.

Having completed a B.A. and H.D.E. qualification at Rhodes University in the late 1970's, Anthony spent the first three years of his professional career as a High School teacher in Namibia. After relocating to Cape Town in 1981, Anthony wanted to enter the commercial world and joined the South African division of the UK-based MaST Organisation.

This was the beginning of a life-long career in training and development, dedicated to enhancing individual as well as team performance through business consulting and skills development training solutions.

After two years he took over responsibility for MaST's Cape operations, and was the youngest Director of MaST when the company listed on the Johannesburg Stock Exchange in 1987.

After successfully designing and delivering a wide range of personal and interpersonal, leadership, coaching, and team-building solutions at MaST for over 12 years, Anthony chose a new direction and in 1993 he joined Stratagem, an organisation delivering training solutions in business finance and total quality management.

During his time with Stratagem Anthony enrolled at Henley Management College to begin an international Executive MBA degree, which he completed in 2002.

In 1999 he started his own business, Omni Learning, focused on combining his then almost 20 years of acquired experience to provide his clients with custom-designed solutions to drive their "people development" strategies.

In 2000 Anthony became a licensed practitioner of the world-wide Insights organisation, which he left in 2009 to join UK-based Lumina Learning as a fully accredited business affiliate.

In 2015 Anthony was appointed as a Consultant Partner to LSP Leadership to lead their coaching consulting services and leadership & coaching training in South Africa.

Anthony's passion for education led him to serve as the Chairman of the LEAP board of governors. LEAP Science and Maths Schools were established to be part of the solution for the education crisis in SA. LEAP has now developed into one of the most powerful, inspiring and successful non-profit educational initiatives in South Africa.

Anthony has been married to Candace since 1979, and they have a son, Christopher. Anthony is based in Cape Town, but travels widely. He has facilitated training workshops throughout SA as well as in the UK, Europe, Canada and Australia during his career.
